The City of Dunn has received a \$1,000,000 STAG Grant under P.L. 117-103, for the City's Black River Wastewater Plant improvement project to perform infrastructure improvements and upgrades to the Black River Wastewater Plant. This program is administered by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) under the provisions of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act. Federal Regulations, namely 40 C.F.R. Parts 5 and 7, provides that no person shall be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving EPA assistance on the basis of race, color, national origin, or on the basis of sex in any program or activity receiving EPA assistance under the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, as amended, including the Environmental Financing Act of 1972. As a STAG Grant recipient, the City of Dunn, is committed to ensuring compliance with these regulations and has designated the Human Resource Director as the City's compliance officer.
