

## **Notice: Water System Valve Maintenance Program Now Underway**

The City is beginning a routine water valve maintenance program throughout the water distribution system.

A newly assigned crew will be inspecting and operating (exercising) water system valves as part of ongoing maintenance. Valves are being turned on and off to ensure they function properly.

What this means:

- Valves are being turned to ensure they function properly
- This helps improve reliability during repairs and emergencies
- Supports long-term performance of the water system

What residents may notice:

- Temporary low water pressure
- Brief service interruptions in some areas
- Possible discolored or cloudy water that should clear after flushing

If you experience discolored water, run cold water from a faucet (preferably a bathtub or outdoor spigot) until it clears. Avoid using hot water appliances, including dishwashers and washing machines, until the water runs clear.

Updates will be posted as crews progress through different sections of the water distribution system.
